



## Shamrock Shake

After that, they will be available at the school store while supplies last. Students will be learning about the harmful effects plastics have on our earth leading up to Earth Day—April 22, 2019. Any profit from the sale of these items will be donated to the World Wildlife Fund to help endangered animals.



## **Stainless Steel Straws 75 cents**

9.5 inches long. Americans use 500 million plastic straws a day! They are ending up in our waterways causing damage to marine life.



## **Shopper Tote Bag \$3.00**

20W x 13H x 8D. The lifespan of one reusable bag saves 700 plastic bags. Over one person's lifetime, you will save 22,000 plastic bags!



## **Push Cap Water Bottle \$3.00**

20 ounces. 50 million water bottles are thrown away everyday in the US alone.
